WEBSITE PRIVACY STATEMENT

Willow Park First Year School (hereafter "Willow Park School") is committed to preserving the privacy of all visitors to www.willowparkschool.ie ("our website"). This privacy statement relates to our practices in connection with our website. Willow Park School fully respects the right to privacy. We will not collect personal information/personal data about you when you visit our website unless you choose to send us an e-mail by clicking "Contact Us". By using this site, you consent to the collection and use of your information under the terms of this privacy statement which is in accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation of 2016/679 and the European Communities (Electronic Communications Networks and Services) (Privacy and Electronic Communications) Regulations 2011. Please read the following privacy statement to understand how we use and protect the information that you choose to provide to us.

Personal information which we collect from you

Information provided by sending us an e-mail is directly sent to the Registrar of Willow Park School.

Use of your information

Any information which you provide by sending us an e-mail is not made available to any third parties and is only used by Willow Park School in line with the purposes for which you provided it.

Non-Personal information which we collect

Where you visit our website, certain non-personal data is available to us through our internet service provider. This non-personal data is collected on a statistical, aggregate, non-individual basis. This information may include the IP address from which you access our website, the type of browser used to access our website (Internet Explorer, Firefox, etc.), the type of operating system used to access our website (Windows, Macintosh, etc.), the "top-level" domain name used (.ie, .com, .org, etc.), the date and time of your visit to our website and the number of pages you visited on our website.

IP Addresses Anonymisation in Analytics

Willow Park School website is a customer of Google Analytics which is a freemium web analytics service that tracks and reports website traffic.

An IP address is a number that is assigned to your computer automatically when you use the internet. When you visit any web page in our website Analytics anonymises the address as soon as technically feasible at the earliest possible stage of the collection network. The IP anonymisation feature in Analytics sets the last octet of IPv4 user IP addresses and the last 80 bits of IPv6 addresses to zeroes in memory shortly after being sent to the Analytics Collection Network. The full IP address is never written to disk in this case.

The process of IP anonymisation in Analytics takes place within two steps in the collection pipeline: the JavaScript Tag and the Collection Network. These steps are explained below.



When IP Anonymisation takes place the last three digits of IP addresses are translated into zero (0) which provides an accurate source of website visitors' *country* and less accurate source of *city*. Your anonymaised IP address is used *only* to gather broad demographic information.

Cookies

A cookie is a small file sent to your browser from a Web server and stored on your computer's hard drive to identify you as the user of the website. Typically they are used by the website to identify the person accessing the website to track the person's use of the site and any repeat visits made by that person.

In general, cookies are used to retain user preferences, store information for things like shopping carts, and provide anonymised tracking data to third party applications like Google Analytics. As a rule, cookies will make your browsing experience better.
